

1st Corinthians Course Introduction

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Basic Structure of Course

1. This will be a verse by verse study but I want you to have read the material well ahead of the actual verse by verse study.
2. There will be questions for each chapter and the questions will be reviewed and discussed in class.
3. There is a self-test at the beginning and one at the end of the class. The purpose of these two tests is to see if you learned anything.
 - a. The first should be taken within the first few classes and kept
 - b. The second, should be taken on the last day of the quarter AND it should be taken without looking at the first test.
 - c. Then you will want to compare your answers between the two tests.
 - d. This is optional.
 - e. A set of answers will be provided from the teachers at the end of the quarter.
4. We have 12 weeks (24 classes) to cover 16 chapters so we will take time for questions and discussion. Typically we will cover 1-2 chapters per week. Some weeks we will cover more and other weeks we will cover less.
5. Please ask questions and provide comments
 - a. Questions help all of us to learn. Most likely someone else is wondering the same thing so just ask.
 - b. Each person provides a different view points and this too helps us all to learn and broaden our understanding of the scriptures.
