16:1-2 Phoebe – Who is she and why Paul gives her special notice?

- She is a Sister in Christ!
- She is a Sister in Need!
- She is a Servant to Others!

16:3-16 – Greetings All Around!

- 26 people identified in this final greeting (24 named specifically)
- More than simply greetings, Paul identifies relationships
 - They are more than acquaintances
 - They have a deep care and love for each other
 - They are close even in their diversity
