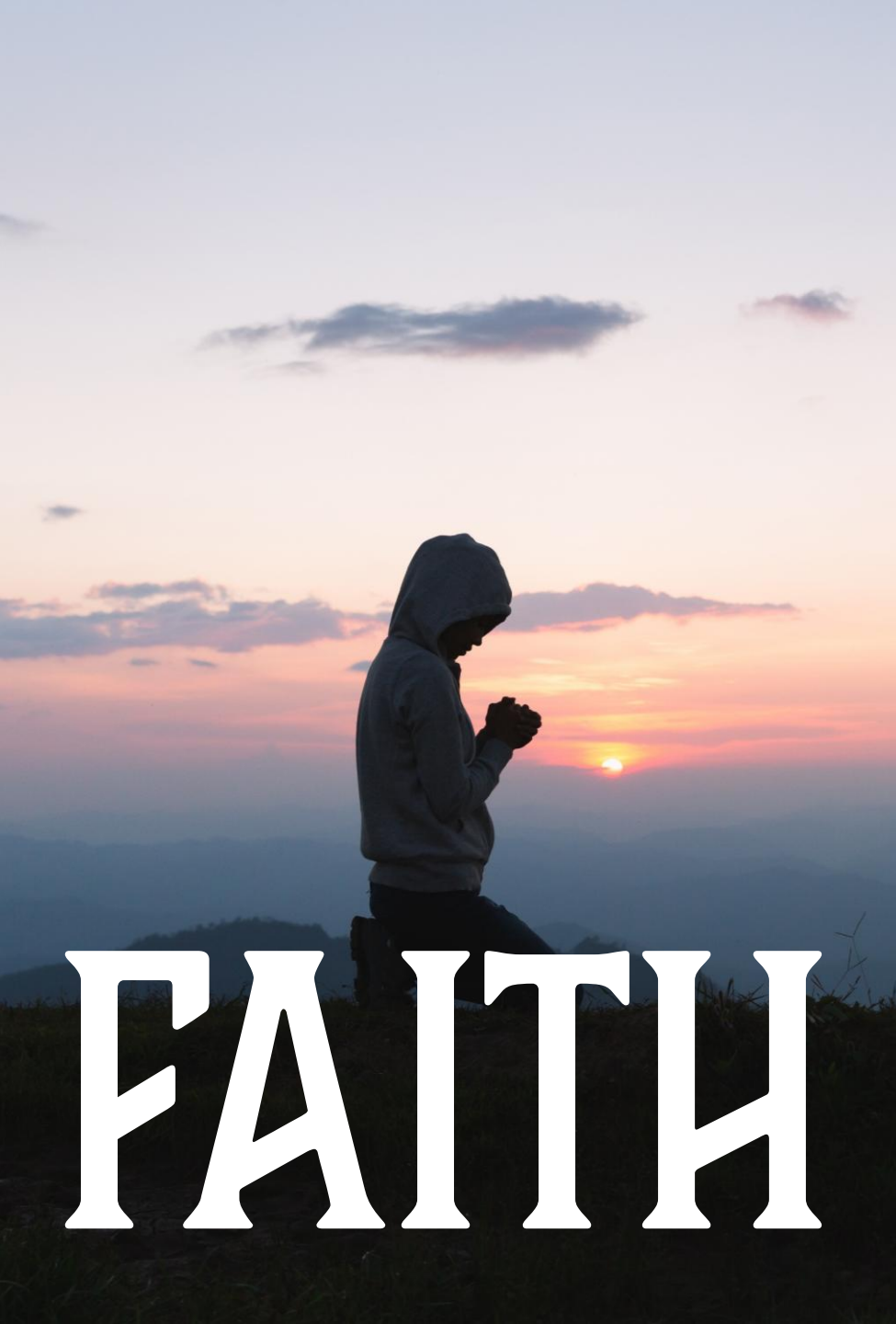

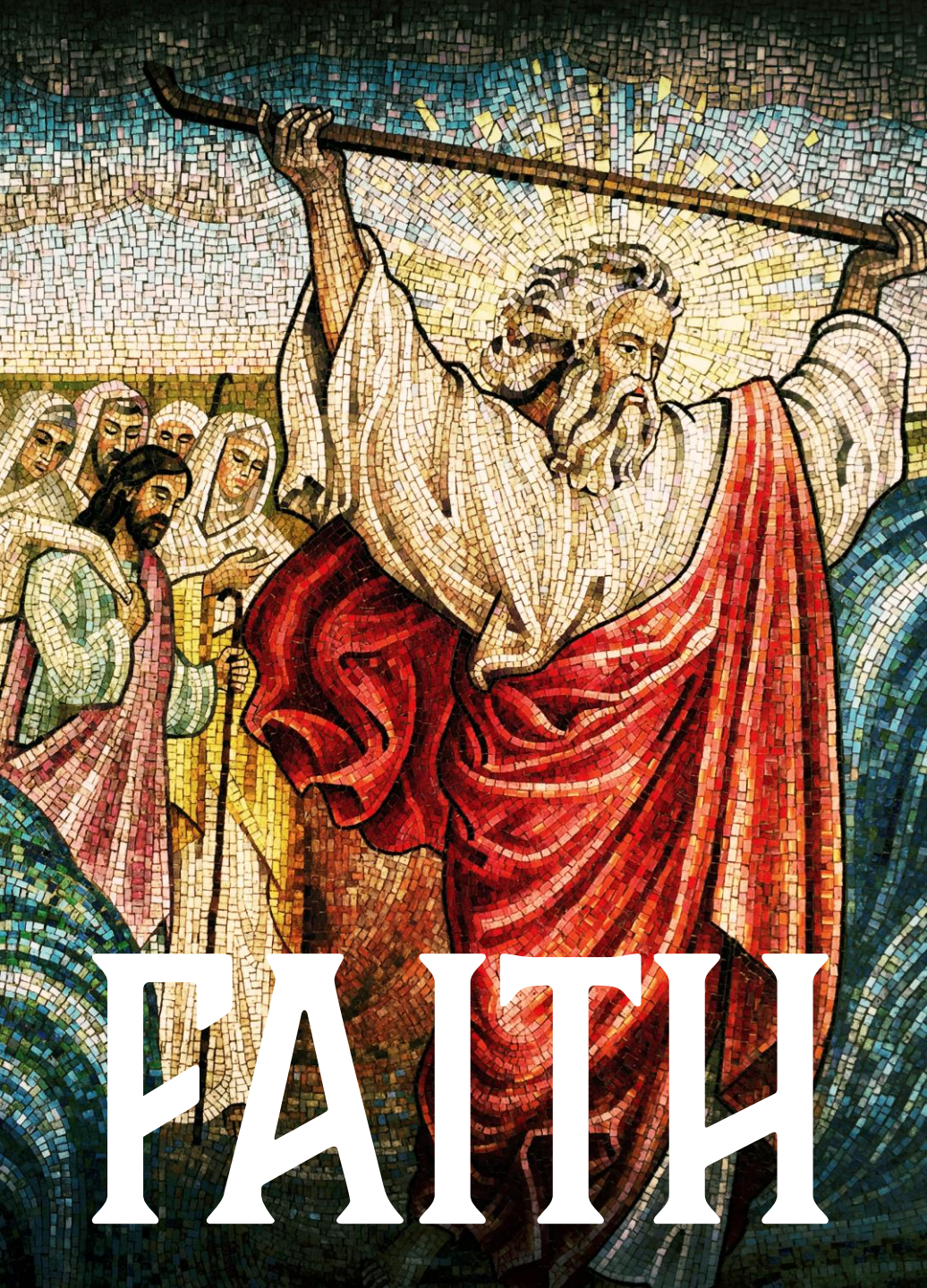

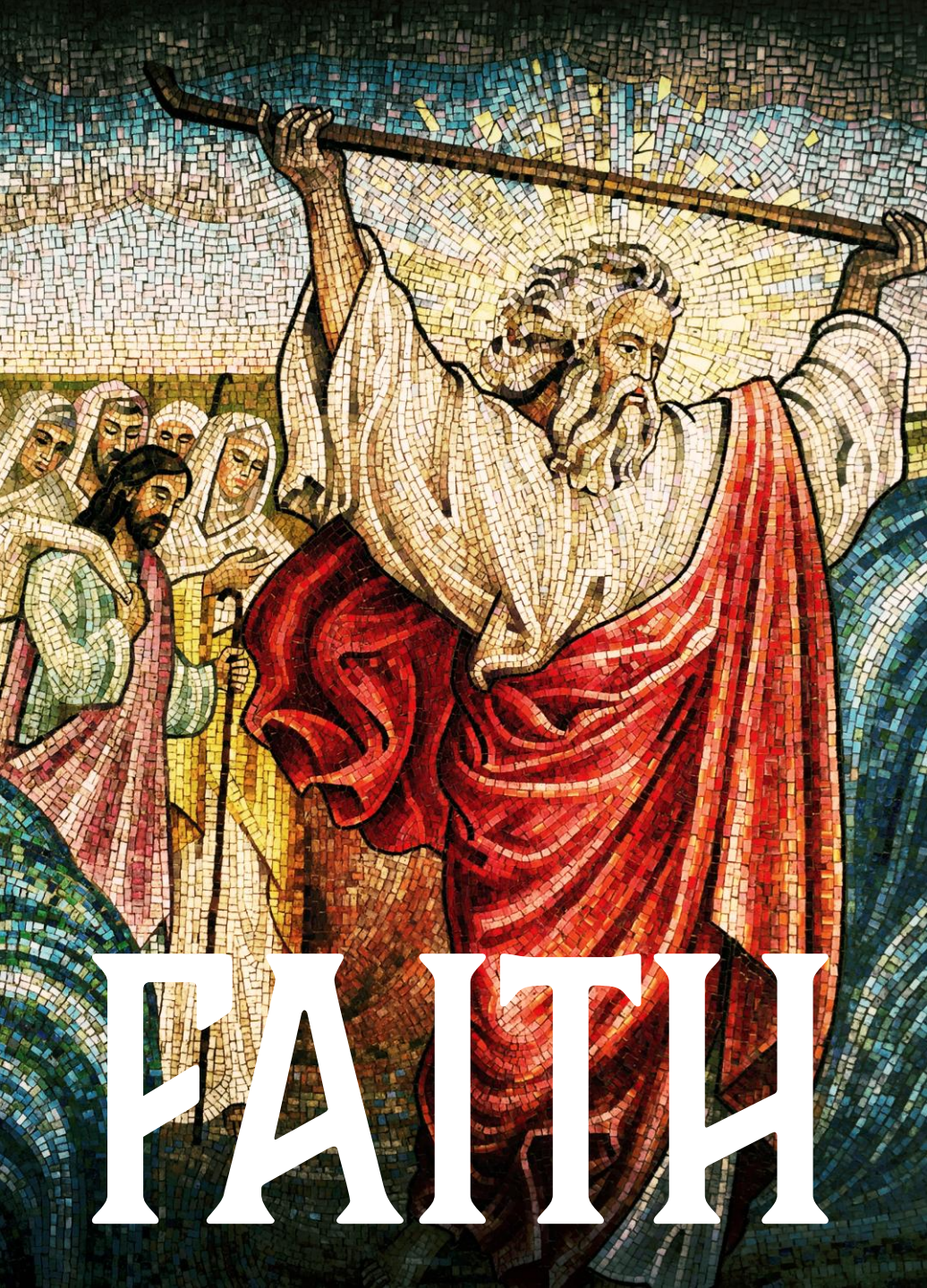
So he answered, “Do not fear, for those who are with us are more than those who are with them.”– **2nd Kings 6:12-13**

– **Hebrews 11:1**



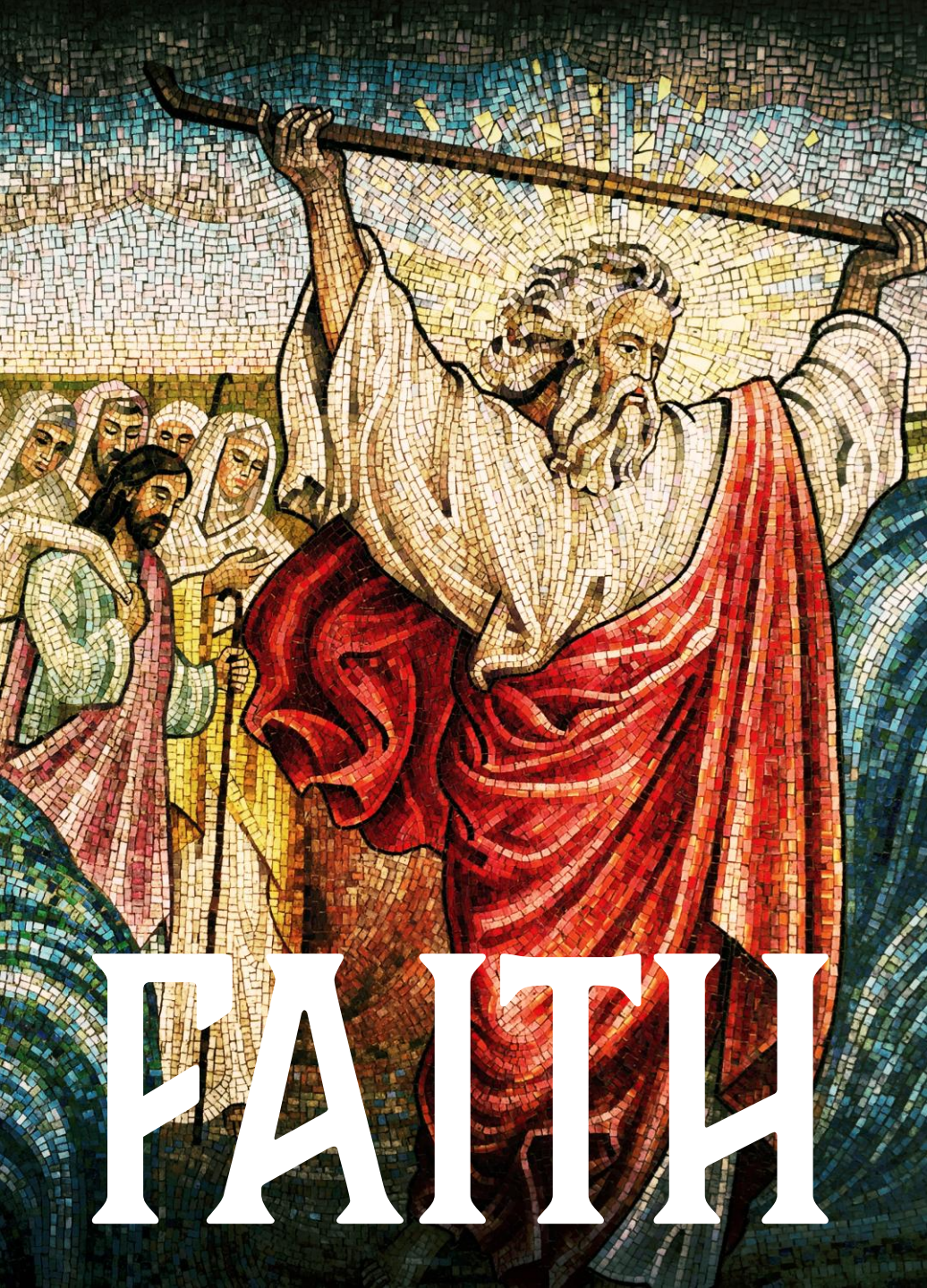
